Sentence Types: Simple, Compound, Complex, and ...

Examples: 1. The baby cried for food. ^There is a subject and a verb that expresses a complete thought. 2. Professor Maple's intelligent students completed and turned in their homework. ^A

simple sentence does not necessarily have to be short. It can have adjectives. In this case, there are two verbs "completed" and "turned in."
